Team able to lead own activities in future.</p>	300	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All KS2 pupils at the site participate in a weekly offsite planned within the Forest Schools framework</li> <li>Site staff more confident in delivery and planning of the weekly activities</li> <li>Compliance and safety areas covered and addressed for sustainability of the project – site staff now able to undertake some aspects of the planning</li> </ul>
