To be topped-up from school budget Currently, the lack of a safe space restricts the amount of physical activity that pupils can do at break times 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All pupils at Barrow Hill will have access to a safe environment for sporting activities during breaks in the nurture programme. As pupils are keen to see this happen, the expectation is that there will be a 100% participation rate in sporting activities on site, as there is with offsite 'forest school' activities A wider range of sporting activities can be accessed, including individual and team-based sports 	£4,600*	A new enclosed MUGA and work area has been constructed at the KS2 site. This has ensured that the pupils have a dedicated and safe outside space in which to play. They are able to climb and develop their hand, eye coordination whilst engaging in activities to develop their social skills. There is now safe surface for them to play and engage in physical activity.
